- I. Campus Updates
 - a. Childcare Center Update
 - i. Tentative opening date is January 2016.
 - ii. Location: Tacoma Children's Museum on the basement level.
 - iii. There are no further updates on how space will be allocated.
 - b. Staff Professional Development Taskforce Update by Linda Patterson, Director of Professional Development
 - Professional Development Taskforce started in 2013. The taskforce discovered a lot of different professional development approaches, so decided to look at professional development broadly.
 - ii. Created a menu of professional development options, along with information and suggestions on how to pursue professional development.
 - iii. UW Tacoma Professional Development is currently offering management development training for supervisors and managers and offers sponsored workshops.

 - c. VCAA search: The search committee is preparing to conduct airport interviews. No on-campus interviews have been planned yet. The search firm, Diversified Search, for the VCAA position is the same firm used for the Chancellor search.
 - d. Plans for filling the Institute of Technology and Education director positions are in progress.

- VI. Campus Smoking Policy, Dave Leonard from Occupational Health & Safety
 - a. Presented on the current WAC and the UW policy. UW follows rules governed by WAC 478-136-035 in setting smoking policy. The aim is to minimize second hand smoke.
 - b. Smoking is prohibited on campus except for in designated smoking areas.
 - c. UW Tacoma plans to improve signage around campus and increase awareness.
 - d. New signs will explicitly include vapers/e-cigarettes with the same restrictions
