CES Degree change: Replace TCES 455 Devices and Controls with TEE 451 Control Systems

Max led a discussion with the engineering faculty regarding replacing TCES 455 Devices and Controls with TEE 451 Control Systems due to low enrollment in the CES course. This would allow for one class to be offered for both computer and electrical engineering students together. This would also free up the faculty member who teaches Devices and Controls to be able to teach masters level classes. This change will be effective Autumn quarter 2022-23.
