Updates and news:

1- Approve minutes of last meeting: March 5, 2021

2- Updates on new student applications

- PhD was the first priority, then [Thesis/Capstone?](#) reviews, then MSCSS reviews
- Now that we are in April we will start focusing on MSCSS applications for Fall

3- Update on PhD student support [Wes, Eyhab, Ankur and Mohamed]

- An email was sent to faculty to fill out an online application for funding

4- Online MSCSS degree and certificates in the future.[Mohamed]

- Microsoft employees are interested in an online PhD with full support from MS
- The size of online courses needs to be addressed with regard to workload
- Any students with Engineering backgrounds can be TA eligible

Discussions:

7- adding a track for elective courses that do not fall under any track for PhD

- Student must take a minimum of 20 credits in electives. 15 credits need to be from three MS tracks. Some good courses are not in a track. Creating a challenge for PhD students to complete the required 20 credits efficiently

- Is there a possible "track" to create for PhD electives that could capture some of these courses?
- One example is the VR course 578, not in a track
- Other ways to do elective substitutions?
- Ankur is working on it

8- PhD handbook

- We will work on a PhD handbook with Curtis, or an online version
- Should be a resource to figure out electives, tests, dissertation, funding

9- Course planning for next year

- How best to schedule CORE courses in Autumn/Winter?
- Possible to do one giant online section every quarter for CORE courses
- One 543 online offered in Autumn, one 558 online offered in Winter
- Also have an in person CORE offered the following quarter for students who missed, or failed

10- 700/702 registration before proposal acceptance

- Now students wait for a code to register until after acceptance
- This sometimes creates anxiety and students register for a "holding place" course
- F1 students, and veterans, worry about not being at 10 credits
- Spring term see "Musical Chairs" with enrollment and creates issues with schedule
- Could we also improve the process of reviewing the proposals-- treat 700 and 702 differently during the review process
