A personal goal statement describing your interest in criminal justice and your desired educational outcomes

- Upload CJ personal goal statement

- > Apply to UW Tacoma, <u>www.tacoma.uw.edu/admissions/transfer-admissions-requirements</u>
- > Submit <u>all</u> official transcripts

- > Visit the SSWCJ website and submit CJ Program application
