Stippling is an artistic technique in which images are illustrated and shaded using only points. No lines are used. In my talk, we will be computer generating stipple art, in a process known as Lloyd's Algorithm. After presenting the process, we will stipple some examples in real time with our computer program implemented in Javascript.
