- **2.** ABET
  - Visit is 2 weeks away
  - Volunteers needed for classroom visits (20 min per class)
    - i. Ankur and Chuck have volunteered already
  - Want to interview a teaching faculty, Associate Faculty, and Full Faculty
     i. D.C., Chunming, Yan or Bryan and Ankur volunteered
  - Also want to meet with advisors (Beth and Kira)
  - Areas to show evaluators on Sunday
    - i. JOY 009, JOY 001, CP 206C, DOU 110
  - IT labs will be presentable ahead of visit
  - Advisors will explain what the UW IXX and 2XX courses mean (question from ABET evaluators)
  - Rachel and Alice have been coordinating schedule
- **3.** Advising
  - Seniors need to apply to graduate. Please make sure to have students schedule an appointment with advisors to do this.
  - We have done outreach to every student who needs TWRT 291. This could be made into a pre-requisite for TINFO 482 to ensure students take it timely.
  - Conversation about moving core curriculum around to better prepare students. Advising can suggest a new curriculum grid.
  - Plug to have faculty/ seminar leaders share concerns about students early so advisors can outreach promptly

- Attendance has been ok in Bryan's/ Deveeshree's sections, well in D.C.'s/ Ankur's/ Chuck's/ Jim's
- Request to offer 481 in Summers
  - Reminder from Deveeshree we should still push students to look for an internship given industry standards
- 4. Seminar Leaders (Zach and Jaime)
  - Going well so far. Attendance is pretty strong- most students reach out ahead of time if they aren't able to attend
  - Have opted to do 1 in person meeting a week and 1 hybrid day of a virtual check in
  - Section B students stumbled on the labs initially, but seem to be doing better
- 5. Ferando Maymi to visit November 10<sup>th</sup>
  - Speaking to all IT majors
  - Offering extra credit (15 points for the course of their choice)
  - On November 12<sup>th</sup> he's speaking to the MCL students
- **6.** Revising Core Courses
  - Discussion of restructuring Junior year and whether these courses should stay in the Core or not
  - Proposed offering courses multiple times a year, but D.C. didn't get much feedback from the team
  - Want a 10-year review of the program internally (technology we teach students out of date, etc.).
  - Request to create a subcommittee to look into this (D.C., Beth, and Yan volunteered to do this). This group will create a proposal by the next IT committee meeting
  - Bryan is going to update his 320 course, which is going to be a better experience for students
- 7. 1503 Updates Proposed
  - Proposed to require TCSS 142/ CSE 142 instead of TCSS 141
  - Question from advisors whether we should keep the IAC option as well as Digital Forensics- or whether we could keep just the one general IT major (which may be clearer for ABET and support students better in the long run)
