2. Advisors

o Students are interested in being seminar leaders next year. o C# and Web development. Some students are struggling – Facilitators are referring to faculty. o Deveeshree is looking for a grader, student needs to have a 3.5 or higher in class. o Deadline for application for the new seminar leaders is March 10, at 6pm.

4. MSIT

o Was approved and must go now before the board of Regents o Projected start September 2024

5. MCL

o May have two cohorts – must double teaching load o Could have bigger sections instead o Would need more than 50 new students to be able to open a 2nd cohort

6. Cheating

o If Faculty see odd duplicated errors o If cheating is found – notify Bryan, he will report o Explain to students why cheating is bad

7. ABET

o Weakness – we were not following proper assessment strategies o Should not be using grade averages – should use more fidelity o Rubric has been developed to measure one course outcome o TCSS 325 instructor has separated the data based on major o Beth suggested we offer sections of TCSS 325 that are restricted to only TINFO students o D.C. asked if IT should offer TINFO 325 o Ankur suggested IT really needs course stewards. She sees that knowledge base is disjointed in 482 because faculty teach core courses very differently o Faculty need to get together and decide as a group which material needs to be covered and when o Curriculum day should be a time when all major faculty meet together to work on curriculum changes to ensure outcomes are met for students and ABET o Transfer equivalents are not able to be added to UW equivalency guide – advisors note on UWXX credits will now be more explicit o Bryan has asked for more faculty positions o Faculty take a look at ABET outcomes, add more classes if possible o Please help Bryan with data for C, D, and E, faculty has until July 25th to submit changes for accreditation
