DEGREE provides knowledge and skills to those who plan to seek employment in a wide-range of non-profit, law enforcement, human service, legal and correctional settings. A social justice focus is adopted throughout the program, with an emphasis placed on preventive, rehabilitative and restorative approaches to crime and justice.

Criminal Justice majors might pursue careers in a wide-variety of settings following graduation. Whether you are interested in becoming a victim advocate, a reentry case manager, work in a correctional facility or do prevention work with youth in the community, a criminal justice degree can provide the knowledge and skills necessary to pursue a career that makes a difference in the lives of others.

PURSuing LAW SCHOOL OR OTHER GRADUATE STUDIES

While many students go on to pursue professional careers in justice-related, non-profit or human service fields after obtaining their degree, graduates of this major may also decide to continue on for advanced degrees in disciplines such as social work, sociology, law or criminal justice.
