### **Departmental Information**

SPECIAL ALLOCATIONS - CRITERIA

Our Annual Allocations Proposal for the 2023-2024 academic year was approved but modified from the original request to our 10-30% reduction. We request a special allocation to clarify information that may have been misinterpreted. This new submission should relate directly to our prior proposal.

#### STUDENT UTILIZATION

Our prior proposal stated that the VMRC goal is to increase student success, improve the student experience at UW Tacoma, and increase militaryconnected student engagement. We had 17.83% Of Military-Affiliated for Autumn 2022 (Total Enrollment- 4801). This year, we have over 800 Military Connected students - we maintain solid enrollments and a wide variety of diversity while growing collaborations with other student unions and alums councils. Moving forward, we will use the funds to host campus events and workshops that highlight various cultural backgrounds and interests. These are opportunities for students to learn from those whose experiences and perspectives differ from their own. Social connectedness helps remove any stigma some may have towards military culture and beliefs.

#### SPECIAL ALLOCATIONS - STATEMENT OF ASSURANCES

Each week, the VMRC receives hundreds of students who utilize the center for multiple purposes. The growing number of visits shows the pressing need for resources and engagement. The prior proposal outlines multiple programs that will enhance the college experience for military-connected students.

#### SERVICE BENEFITS TO STUDENTS

The most meaningful way our services benefit students is by integrating veteran students into civilian communities where they've felt misunderstood and helping them connect with non-military-connected students. We have a post-graduation survey that confirms if they felt that their military-connected identity was supported by the VMRC and what they most enjoy at UW Tacoma and the VMRC.

Good Afternoon SAF Committee,

We understand the difficulty of the current situation. As a result, we are proposing a 30% cut to our request. Ultimately our philosophy was to cut line items that impacted as few students as possible and still allowed us to maintain core operations and build a supportive community. These cuts are tough to make and will have an impact, but we have strategized on ways to mitigate their effect.

The Student Activities Funding Committee (SAFC) sincerely hopes that your spring quarter is going well. We are writing to inform you that we are presently engaged in the process of reviewing all the proposals for the 2022-2023 annual allocation.

We regret to inform you that the total initial request for all proposals amounts to nearly \$3.4 million, which exceeds last year's request by approximately \$900,000. Our budget allocation for the upcoming fiscal year is \$1.9 million. Consequently, if we were to fund all the requests, we would be facing a shortfall of \$1.5 million.

To overcome this fiscal challenge, we respectfully request each proposer to prepare a proposal reduction plan ranging from 10% to 30% of the requested allocation for your program and submit it for our review. Our goal is to ensure that each proposal is given equitable consideration while maintaining fiscal responsibility.

We acknowledge and appreciate your patience in this matter. We will make every effort to accommodate your proposals in a fair and equitable manner.
