



Tuition Exemption Policy

The School of Nursing and Healthcare Leadership (SNHCL) is implementing a revised tuition exemption (TE) policy to be effective spring quarter 2024. Under the newly revised Master of Nursing (MN) degree program there will be two courses (10 total credits) eligible for TE:

- T NURS 539: The Science & Art of Leading & Managing in Healthcare (5 credits)
- T NURS 548: Biopsychosocial Interventions for Advanced Nursing Practice (5 credits)

Per UW policy, students may only register up to 12 credit hours using TE. However, due to the change in course credit hours in the MN program, only 10 credits would be eligible for TE.

Consistent with current SNHCL practices, the two undergraduate programs, RN-BSN and BAHCL will continue to offer tuition exemption on a space available basis per RCW.28B.15.558.

STUDENT IMPACT & MITIGATION

Eligible MN TE students admitted prior to the 2023-2024 academic period may continue to use their current tuition exemption benefits through spring quarter 2024.
