UW AREAS OF INQUIRY

All students are required to complete UW Areas of Inquiry as part of their general education requirements for their bachelor's degree. Areas of Inquiry include courses in Arts and Humanities (A&H), Social Sciences (SSc), and the Natural Sciences (NSc).

A&H – Courses include art, communication, film, or humanities.

SSc – Students must choose an anthropology, psychology, or sociology course.

NSc - Courses include chemistry, biology, environmental science, geology, and mathematics.

Note: Some of these requirements may be completed through prerequisite or program coursework.
