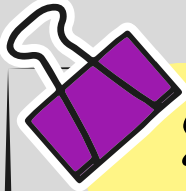
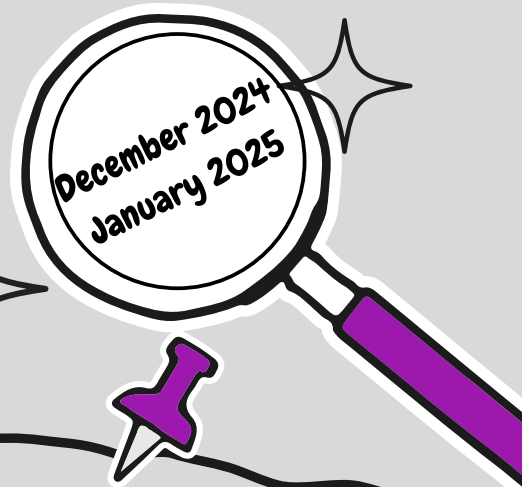

Soft Skill Focus: **INTEGRITY**

This month's soft skill focus will be on **Integrity**. Teaching your child integrity is crucial because it helps them develop a strong moral compass, allowing them to make ethical decisions, build trust with others, and navigate life's challenges. By consistently **doing the right thing, even when it's difficult**, children can shape their character and prepare themselves for a responsible and fulfilling life including fairness, accountability, and empathy.

How can your child show **INTEGRITY** in the classroom?

- follow classroom rules
- no cheating
- be prepared for class
- have assignments completed on time
- be on time for school
- do not disrupt class
- come to class ready to learn



How can parents teach **INTEGRITY** at home?

- Model integrity at home: Children learn by watching and imitating adults.
- Provide opportunities to make choices: Give children opportunities to make choices that match their values, such as caring for a pet or helping out with family.
- Practice empathy: Help children understand how their actions affect others.

Teach your child to use **INTEGRITY** with Classmates by showing them how to:

- offer to help others
- stand up for the underdog
- use kind and encouraging words
- listen when someone else is speaking
- follow through with promises and commitments
- **BE HONEST!**
