Services & Activities Fee (SAF)

- Authorized by state statute
- Supplements state & tuition investment
- Student-directed funding for student activities & programs
- Current SAF is \$164/quarter (that's ~\$2.2M annually!)
- This year's committee voted to increase the SAF to \$167/quarter
- Current UWY fee is \$180/quarter

Services & Activities Fee Committee (SAFC)

- 7 voting student members (minimum); referred to Chancellor by ASUWT, appointed by Chancellor
- 4 non-voting ex-officio members (ASUWT, SA, F&A, Faculty)
- 1 non-voting compliance officer
- Comply with Open Public Meetings Act (RCW 42.30)



SAFC Responsibilities

- Review all requests for funding from S&A Fees
- Recommend program priorities and budget levels
- Recommend fee amount, within guidelines
- Serve in an advisory capacity to the Chancellor
- Propose revisions to Bylaws
- Members recuse themselves from voting on funding for programs they are associated with



Initial Requests	\$4,191,604
Proposed Allocation	\$2,315,175
SAF Fee Revenue	\$2,246,000
From Contingency Fund	\$69,175

Contingency Fund	\$1,566,089
Long-Term Fund	\$1,660,506
Total	\$3,226,595

Current Surplus: \$976,595
