



Registered Student Organizations (RSOs) are the University of Washington's term for student groups officially recognized by the university. In return for registering and agreeing to open membership to all students, these groups receive university privileges to better help them conduct business, host events, and reach new prospective members.

At the University of Washington Tacoma, RSO resources are paid for by student fees and operated through the Center for Student Involvement. We believe that RSOs are an important educational tool for helping students connect authentically with others and build leadership skills they will use well after they've graduated.





While students can book study spaces, RSOs can book much, much more, including meeting rooms, classrooms, and large event spaces.


Budget purchases

Requirements

- Group meets minimum registration requirements annually
- Current students are majority members
- Current students are the only voting members
- Non-discriminatory membership policy
- Abide by the student conduct code and all UW policies around the use of space, money, the UW name/logo, and other resources



REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

- At least **four** registered UW Tacoma students serving as officers
- An advisor from UW Tacoma faculty or staff
- A constitution
 - Must include a statement that the majority membership will be students and only students will have voting rights.
 - Must include UW statement of nondiscrimination.

Event Scheduling Access and RSO Access will need to wait for approval. Also if you are denied for Event Scheduling Access you will still retain Simple Meeting Access. Study Session Access and RSO Access are removed at the end of every quarter and will need to be renewed.

Please review the instructions below that pertain to you. Simple Meeting access is granted immediately upon completion of training. Student access is removed quarterly, while RSO access will be removed shortly after commencement every year.

UW TACOMA STUDENTS

Currently enrolled students are required to complete a brief online tutorial to reserve study spaces at UW Tacoma.

UW TACOMA RSO OFFICERS

Training to reserve space and resources for RSO events is available to approved representatives. (Note...You must use your RSOs NetID.)

Simple Meeting and Event Scheduling Trainings are available now. You must complete "Simple Training" to be able to request "Event Access" if needed.


