Registered Student Organizations (RSOs) are the University of Washington's term for student groups officially recognized by the university. In return for registering and agreeing to open membership to all students, these groups receive university privileges to better help them conduct business, host events, and reach new prospective members.

At the University of Washington Tacoma, RSO resources are paid for by student fees and operated through the Center for Student Involvement. **We believe that RSOs are an important educational tool for helping students connect authentically with others and build leadership skills they will use well after they've graduated.**

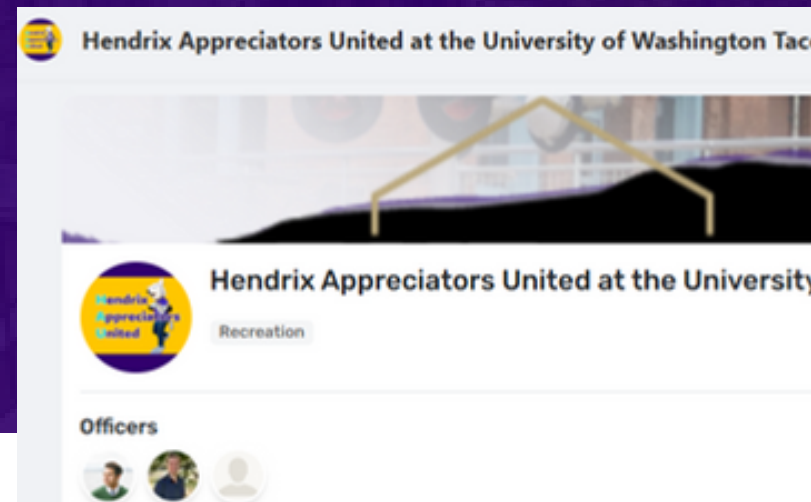
RSO BENEFITS

Registered Student Organizations are allowed to do more so that they can better accomplish group goals.



Group NetID

Every RSO receives a group UW NetID that provides access to email and other online resources



DubNet page

Access to an online page for organizing officers, gathering members, and posting events to a campus calendar



Room booking

While students can book study spaces, RSOs can book much, much more, including meeting rooms, classrooms, and large event spaces.



Budget purchases

Access to two funds for non-food expenses and prepackaged food, respectively.

RSO BENEFITS (CONT'D)

Registered Student Organizations are allowed to do more so that they can better accomplish group goals.



Storage*

May apply for space to store equipment and supplies. Key-accessible lockers, cabinets and desk drawers.



Advertising

Access to the Advertising Request Form on DubNet, allowing ads to be sent to Campus TVs, CSI social media, and a weekly email newsletter.



Promotional supplies

Including a button machine, sticker sheets, trifold boards and more.



RSO Mailbox

Receive group mail at the Center for Student Involvement.

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WHAT DOES UW ASK IN RETURN?

Requirements

- Group meets minimum registration requirements annually
- Current students are majority members
- Current students are the only voting members
- Non-discriminatory membership policy
- Abide by the student conduct code and all UW policies around the use of space, money, the UW name/logo, and other resources

REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

- At least **four** registered UW Tacoma students serving as officers
- An advisor from UW Tacoma faculty or staff
- A constitution
 - Must include a statement that the majority membership will be students and only students will have voting rights.
 - Must include UW statement of non-discrimination.

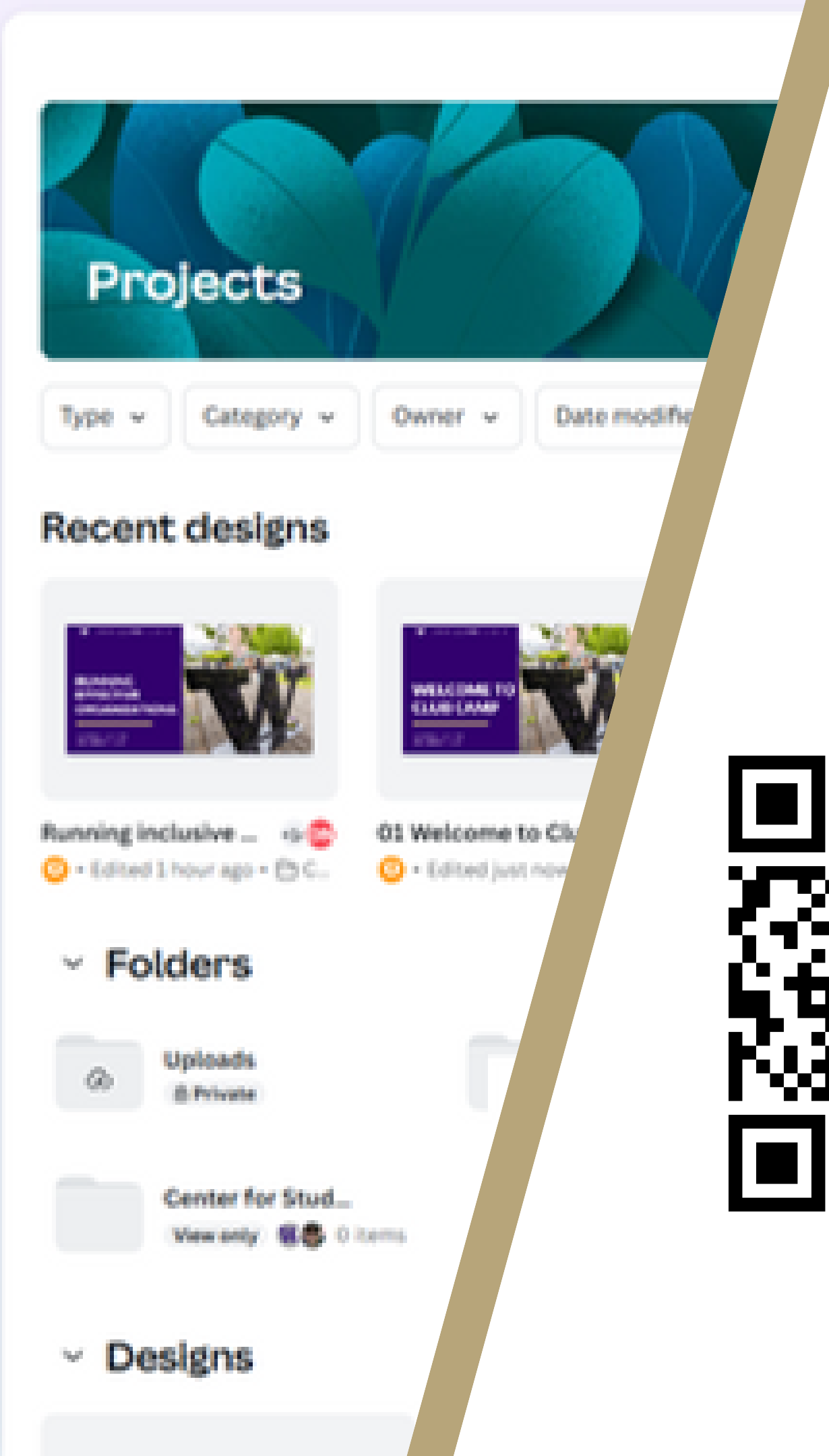
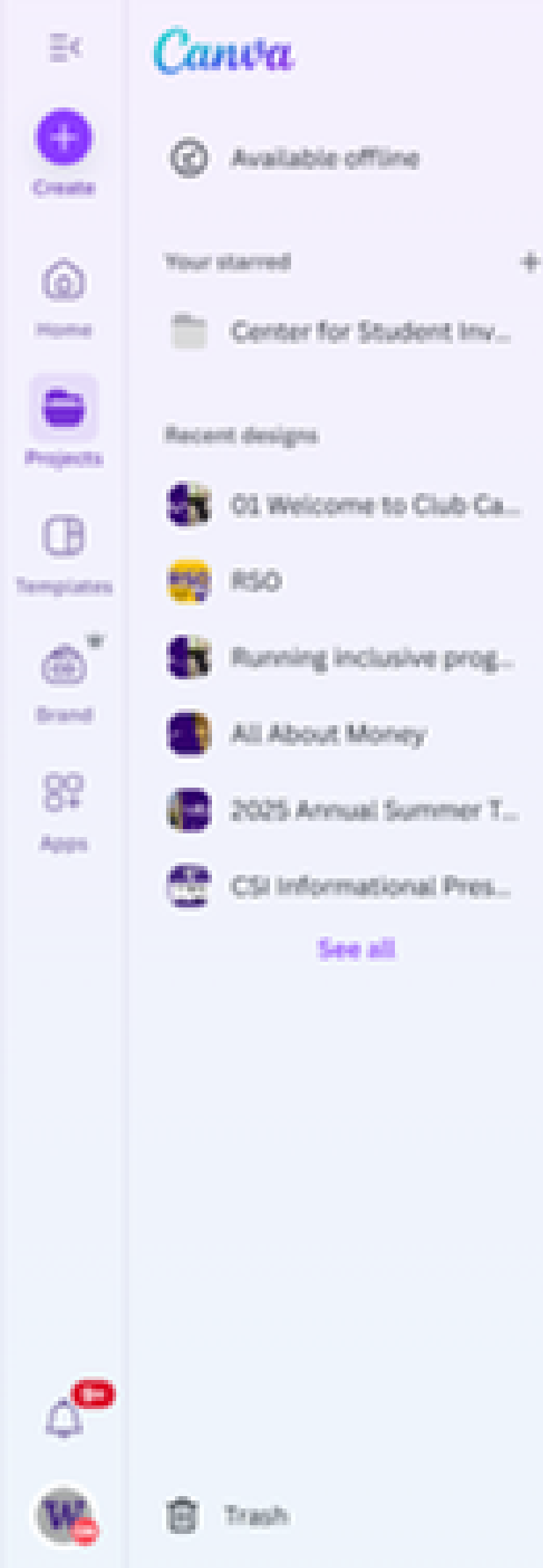
