 - o Invitation to the UW Strategic Planning Committee

 - Standing in union with Central Washington University's adoption of agenda items protecting victims of sexual assault and domestic violence

 - Shuttle service is not likely an option at this time as previously there were not many students taking advantage of the service in relation to the high costs, so YMCA has been supporting the UW Tacoma Pantry, library snacks, etc.
 - Shuttles can be used for RSOs or students with special events if Cassidy is available to drive, such as the Outdoors Club Saturdays' shuttle service

- Senator Barnes shares he has connected with some senators directly with more info about accessibility in registration materials and will email the rest as well as the Executive Board about sharing the information in more detail
- Senator Lawless shares about the HB3's event (Women in Prison in Higher Education) on December 5th sponsored by the Seahawks, where gifts will be provided for the children of formerly incarcerated students. The Seahawks dance team will be present as well.
