## **Departmental Information**

#### SPECIAL ALLOCATIONS - CRITERIA

One of two microwaves in the Dawg House Student Lounge ceased to work at an unknown point in Spring Quarter 2025. A replacement was purchased and will be installed by the time this proposal is reviewed. This proposal requests funding for the replacement equipment.

#### STUDENT UTILIZATION

The Dawg House microwave kitchenette is a popularly used resource in the MAT Dawg House Student Lounge. The Lounge is a public location where students can sit, study, socialize and, for the purposes of this proposal, eat lunch. Though Hot Rod Dog has a restaurant location in the Lounge, the kitchenette enables students to sit and have lunch in a public space without being required to buy something. They can make an economical choice of bringing food from home, which they can reheat on site.

#### SPECIAL ALLOCATIONS - STATEMENT OF ASSURANCES

The microwave has been purchased and will be installed by the time this proposal is reviewed.

#### SERVICE BENEFITS TO STUDENTS

The Center for Student Involvement's office and lounge services help students manage a day on campus more economically by offering alternatives to services they would otherwise have to pay for. This includes access to computers, funded color printing, recreational items, and, relevant to this proposal, accessories and equipment that enable students to bring meals from home. The CSI does not have a means of directly tracking microwave use, but we can look at the indirect metric of utensil use. Across the Dawg House and University YMCA CSI office, students used more than 5,500 compostable plates, 5,700 forks, and 7,100 spoons. Curiously, compostable knife use was comparatively low, at 1,100 units consumed. Regardless, each item individually served 30-40 students per business day.
