Annual Request Information

We are requesting 1 high-end graphic intense computer. Software we'd like to install in these computers is Sketchup Pro, Lumion, and Autodesk software (AutoCAD, Civile 3D, etc.). The general computers we have in WG108 will install these applications, but they will run with very basic features or less than minimum requirements due to low end graphics card. Newer version of these applications requires much better graphics card, memory, and CPU to run properly. Currently we have 2 high-end graphic intense computers. STFC approved 1 in 2025, and we are requesting 1 computer to replace the other surplus computer given by SET and a monitor this time.

The requested devices will be used to continue our objective of having the latest and updated technology available for all University of Washington Tacoma students to use.
