

Delegation to EVCAA pursuant to Executive Order 59

Additional Compensation to Faculty

Purpose

This Administrative Directive is issued in alignment with the **University of Washington Executive Order No. 59, Additional Compensation to Faculty (EO 59)**, and provides a defined UW Tacoma campus-level delegation consistent with that order.

Policy Statement

Per the delegation authority outlined in University of Washington EO 59, Section 4, the Chancellor of the University of Washington Tacoma delegates to the Executive Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs (EVCAA) the authority and responsibilities in EO 59. Specifically, the responsibilities described in Section 4 of EO 59: to establish and communicate standard workload distributions for faculty, and to ensure their equitable application; and, the review and approval of additional compensation requests for faculty, up to 25% of the faculty member's base salary, and the review and request for advance Provost approval for additional compensation requests that exceed the 25% threshold.

Delegation of Authority

Scope of Authority

The Executive Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs is authorized to make administrative decisions, issue directives, and enact/enforce policy as necessary to ensure UW Tacoma's compliance with EO 59 and related faculty compensation policy.

The EVCAA will keep the Chancellor informed of significant decisions, issues, or actions taken related to this Administrative Directive.
