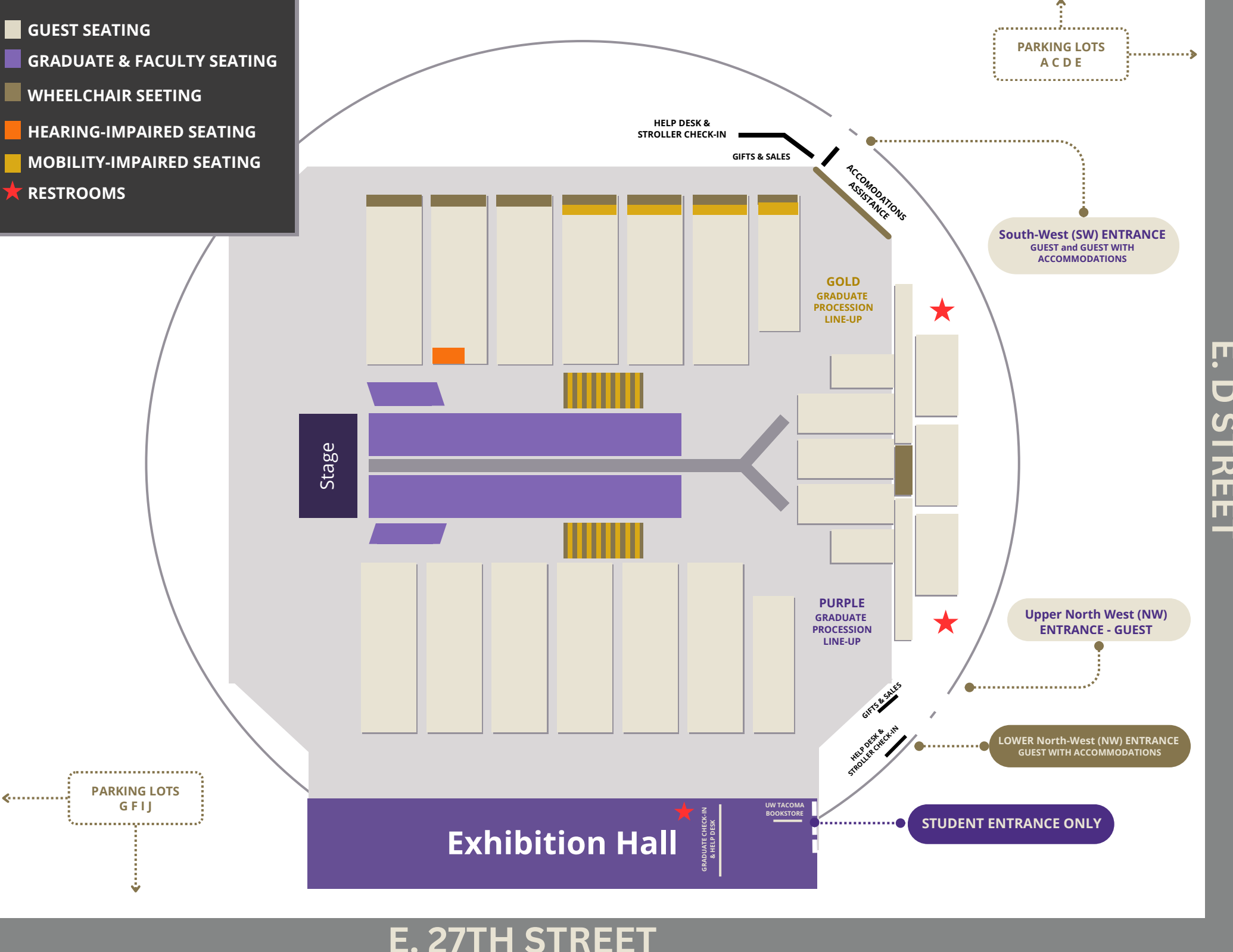


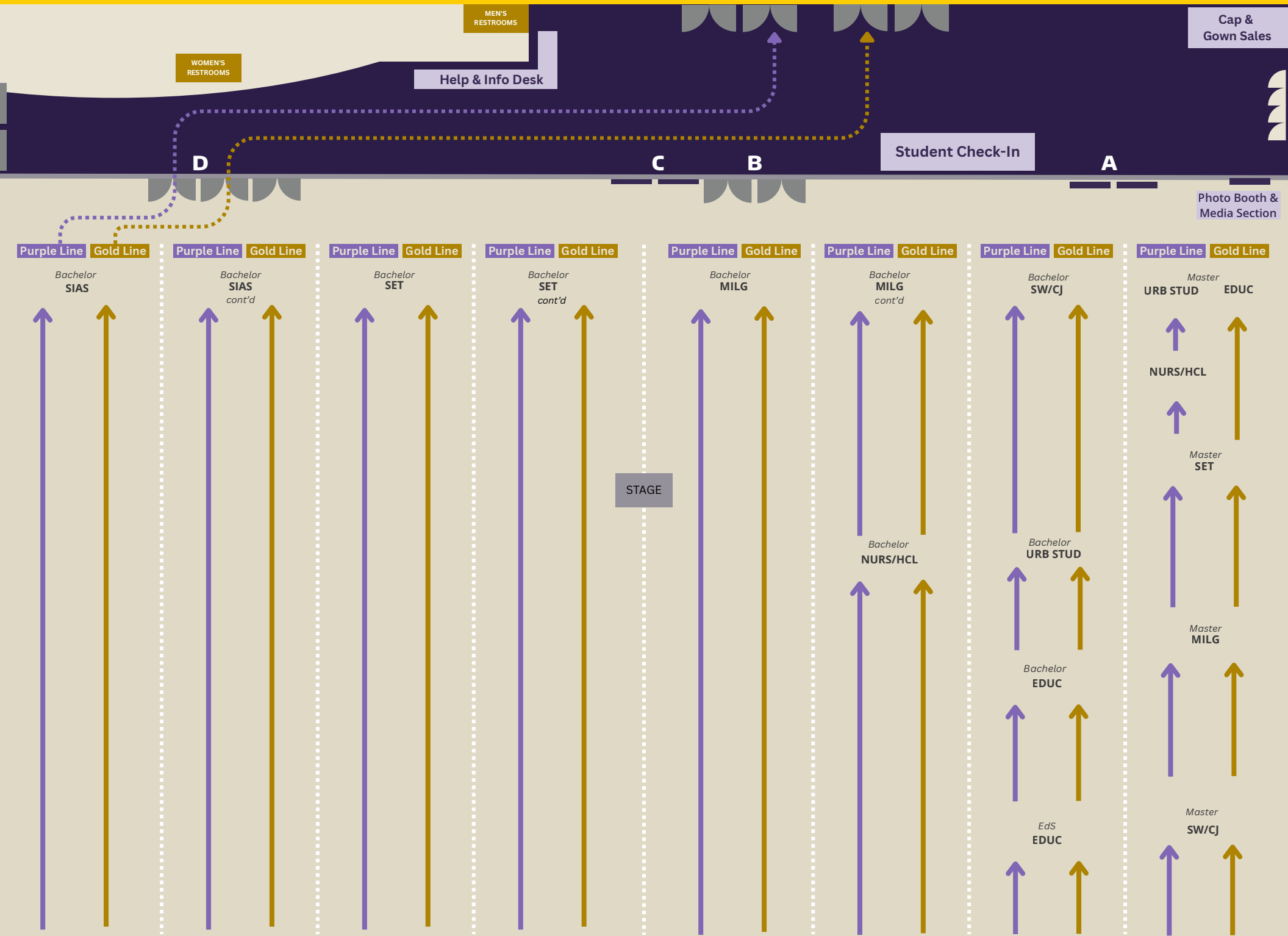

# TACOMA DOME POLICY

## CLEAR BAG POLICY

The Tacoma Dome has a clear bag policy to expedite entry and reduce touch points for security staff and guests.

Tacoma Dome Bag Policy

- Bags may only be clear plastic, vinyl, or PVC, sized 12" x 6" x 12" or smaller
- Small clutch purses are okay if sized 4.5" x 6.5" or smaller
- One gallon plastic storage bags are okay

## SECURITY CHECK & PROHIBITED ITEMS

Everyone will have to go through a security check!

Common items the Tacoma Dome prohibits. Items including, but not limited to, the following are not allowed in the Tacoma Dome:

- Bags that don't adhere to the dome's bag policy
- Outside food & beverage items
- Camera tri-pods, mono-pods, GoPro poles, gimbals, and selfie sticks
- Laptop computers, tablets, and iPads
- Remotely controlled, small unmanned aircraft systems (a.k.a. drones)
- Sticks or clubs (including signs attached to sticks)
- Bullhorns, airhorns or other noisemakers
- Confetti
- Animals, comfort animals, or pets (service animals are allowed)
- Balloons of any kind

### Permitted Items:

- Baby formula, baby bottles and baby food
- Medication or other special needs
- Binoculars
- Seat cushions

## PARKING

Graduates and guests should plan to park either around UW Tacoma campus and take the Tacoma Light Rail, or around the Tacoma Dome. Parking at the Tacoma Dome ranges from \$15-\$30.

# ACCOMMODATIONS

## DISABILITY PARKING

Parking lots E and K are for guests with disabilities and are van accessible. These lots are on a first-come, first-served basis. Vehicles utilizing accessible parking lots must display appropriate placards, tabs, or license plates.

## GUEST ACCOMMODATION ENTRANCE

Guest needing accommodations can enter either through the Lower Northwest Entrance or the Upper Southwest Entrance. Guest needing accommodation may have an attendant with them but we ask you keep the number of attendant reasonable as space is very limited in each section.

## GUEST ACCOMMODATION SEATING

Accommodation seating is primarily on the main floor through NW lower entrance. Please limit to one to two attendants. Cannot be seated while processional is active. Seating is first-come-first-serve

## ELEVATORS

The Tacoma Dome has a public elevator located on the west end of the facility near Sections 109/209. This elevator accesses the Arena Level and the Main Concourse.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

### Nursing & Changing Stations:

Private space is available at events for nursing mothers. The Nursing Mother's room is located on the west end floor level, behind Sections 109-113. Guests should contact their nearest guest services employee with any questions.

### Strollers:

Fold-up strollers may be stored under your seat during events at the Tacoma Dome. If your stroller does not fit under your seat you may check it in prior to the event.
