1. Applicant Motivation

2. Project Purpose & Community Need (500 word limit)

Describe the purpose of this project. How were your community partners involved in identifying the need, challenge, or opportunity this project addresses?

3. Partnerships (500 word limit)

List your community partner(s) and explain how they will be involved in co-creating, implementing, and evaluating the project.

4. Student Engagement (optional, (500 word limit)

How students will participate in this project (e.g., leadership roles, research, community service, internships) and what they will gain from this experience.

5. Project Management (500 word limit)

Explain how you will organize and manage this project. Include how you will structure the project team, team roles, meeting coordination, and collaboration with OCP staff to ensure smooth implementation.

6. Assessment (500 word limit)

What methods of assessment will be used to evaluate the anticipated goals? Has this assessment plan been developed with the community partners?

7. Impact & Sustainability (500 word limit)

Describe the anticipated goals and outcomes for students, faculty/staff, and the community. How will you disseminate or share and sustain the learnings (e.g. results, findings, reports, data, etc.) with your community partner(s).
