"The review committee must solicit reviews from a minimum of three external reviewers. No more than one external reviewer may be from the candidate's doctoral committee, no more than ONE (currently two) may be from the candidate's degree granting institution during the candidate's tenure, AND NO MORE THAN ONE REVIEWER CAN BE A COAUTHOR OF THE CANDIDATE UNDER REVIEW. AN EXTERNAL REVIEWER WHO MEETS TWO OR MORE OF THOSE PRECONDITIONS WILL BE TREATED AS ONE REVIEWER ONLY..."</p> <p>IVC.
