Introduction

The survey offers UW Tacoma students the opportunity to provide the university feedback on their experiences mid-way in the academic year. These data offer the university insights that help inform planning and operational activities that can be used to directly affect student achievement and satisfaction.

Methodology

Participation in the Winter Assessment of the Student Experience survey is completely voluntary. The survey was administered via the UW online survey tool Catalyst. Students registered for classes as of winter quarter census day were sent an email invitation to participate.

Students were offered Likert-type multiple choice questions as well as opportunities for qualitative responses and comments. Respondents could skip any question they chose not to answer, and “skip-logic” formatting displayed some questions to respondents based on an answer to a previous question. Thus some questions were “not shown” to some participants. Though participation in the survey was optional, the response received was a somewhat representative cross section of the greater student population as illustrated in the following table.

Executive Summary

Part One: Campus Facilities, Resources, and Services

To accommodate its growing student population, University of Washington Tacoma continues to focus on developing and improving the campus. New renovation projects are creating additional classroom facilities, and future planned expansion of the campus will create additional academic support and administration offices.

The clear majority of respondents expressed a favorable assessment of the campus with “Maintenance of grounds and buildings” judged as “Excellent” or “Very good” (64.9%). While 48.9% saw the “Quality of classrooms” as “Excellent” or “Very good,” many (37.9%) selected only “Good” as their evaluation of classroom facilities. Of those survey takers having an opinion on the “Quality of labs” (158/283, 55.8%), about fifty-three percent found these facilities to be “Excellent” (25.9%) or “Very good” (27.2%).

As part of the campus renovation effort, UW Tacoma has provided individual and group study spaces, many offering access to learning technologies. When asked to evaluate the availability of places to study on campus, 48% of survey takers said it was “Excellent” or “Very good.”

Administrative support for the student experience centers on providing resources and services that promote student success. Survey takers were asked their level of agreement with a series of statements concerning their interaction with campus provided services to ascertain how UW Tacoma’s delivery of this support is viewed.

Considering only those who provided an evaluative response to this series of statements, most survey takers indicated high levels of positive agreement with statements concerning the approachability of administrators (43.2%) and the professionalism of UWT Staff (46.4%). Responses to the statement “Student Enrollment Services helps address/resolve concerns with the University” were equally positive with 75% “Completely” or “Mostly” agreeing with the statement.

Respondents also felt informed, as in response to the statement “Information that supports student success is readily available at UWT,” about eighty percent “Completely agree” or “Mostly agree” with the statement. Additionally on the same measure, response to “UW Tacoma has a positive environment for students” yielded an evaluation of about 86%.

It is clear that survey respondents feel safe on campus, having told us they “Completely” or “Mostly” agreed campus safety staff responded quickly when needed (91%) and were perceived as “helpful” (90%).

This section of the survey also probed how well used were various on campus services, and if interaction with these services were satisfactory.

Charting a path to degree achievement can benefit from timely and supportive advice. Respondents told us they had used and were satisfied with the services provided by the Academic Advising Center (AAC) (179/282, 45%), although about 16% expressed concerns with their AAC contact. Fewer than nine percent saw no need for AAC services. The campus offers students two opportunities for peer to peer interaction; Student services’ Peer Advisors and the AAC’s Peer Academic Advisors. In both instances, respondents said they had not yet used, but were considering these services (28.8%, 22.6% respectively), but survey takers (94/279, 33.7%) found their use of the AAC Peer Academic Advisor service satisfactory, compared to Student Services’ Peer Advisors (49/281, 17.4%).

About forty-eight percent of respondents reported satisfaction with UWT Computer Services; however, some had concerns with their involvement (14%). Additionally, many survey respondents had no need for the Laptop Checkout service (41%) but 14% of survey takers had either used, or were considering use of the service (31%).

Part Two: Classes, Coursework, and Instruction

The Winter Assessment survey takes place in the second quarter of the academic year. Thus, students have experienced most aspects of academic pursuit offered at the university. Questions presented in this section of the survey sought to examine the student perspective of study and learning offered at UW Tacoma.

Respondents were asked to evaluate how challenging they found the coursework. Most (54.3%) said the challenge was about what they'd anticipated; while 36% said it was "more challenging than expected." When asked to indicate (on a five point scale, 5=completely prepared) how academically prepared they felt for the coursework, nearly 68% felt completely prepared to use computers, but only 37% felt as strongly about "Mathematics" and "Research and Study Skills." However, when considering total responses for scale items 4 and 5, the response to an evaluation of "Overall academics" (82%) and "Study habits" (72%) suggest self confidence in general academic ability.

Student progress to eventual degree requires coordinating one's program requirements and academic schedule. Students were asked their level of agreement with statements focused on classes and coursework. Forty percent of respondents selected "Completely agree" when evaluating the statement "My academic advisor is concerned about me as an individual." And most survey takers said their program's degree requirements were clear and reasonable by selecting "Completely agree" (46%) or "Mostly agree" (31%). But on the topic of class availability, respondents told us they "slightly agreed" or "Mostly agreed" the "Classes I want to take are usually available when I want to take them" (45.7%), with another 32.6% completely, mostly, or slightly disagreeing with the statement. However, survey respondents did tell us the process for signing up for classes is easy, with 79% completely or mostly in agreement.

Many student survey takers were clear when responding to the issue of notification of possible subpar course performance. When those with no opinion are excluded from consideration in the findings, a little over forty-seven percent completely, mostly, or slightly disagreed that "Students are notified early in the term if they are doing poorly in the class."

On the topic of course instruction, respondents were generally positive when assessing UW Tacoma faculty. Where agreement with a statement indicates a positive assessment, respondents saw faculty as fair and unbiased in the treatment of students, with 75% in complete agreement.

UWT faculty is thought to be well prepared and competent, as 64% "Completely agree" they are "...knowledge in their fields of study." And respondents felt class instruction by faculty was effective by completely or mostly agreeing "Faculty teaching methods are effective for my learning style" (70.2%). Though 68.4% responded they completely or mostly agreed "Faculty incorporates technology in a way that enhances my learning" another 22% only slightly agreed and another seven percent mostly or slightly disagreed. When asked to agree with the statement "Professors provide helpful feedback on my academic performance," less than ten percent were in disagreement with the statement, whereas over 88% agreed.

On the topic of course instruction, the overall quality of teaching in all classes taken was favorably judged with 64% selecting "Excellent" and "Very good." Moreover, when asked to tell us about course instruction in their current or planned major, about 64% said it was "Excellent" and "Very good."

While 38% judged the availability of classes offered at times convenient to their schedule was "Excellent" or "Very good", 47% told us the fit was merely "Good" or "Fair." Similarly, 42% reported the variety of courses offered to be "Excellent" or "Very good", a little less than those who saw the variety offered as "Good" or "Fair" (43.6%).

Part Three: About You

Finding one's place in a community of learners is enhanced when the shared academic and social culture allows and invites participation in meaningful ways.

Respondents told us they "Completely" (48.4%) or "Mostly" (31.2%) agree they felt "valued and respected" as students. And most (50% and 34%) completely or mostly agree they were satisfied with their experiences at UWT.

When asked to state their level of agreement with several questions related to their experiences as a UWT student, respondents told us they are meeting their educational objectives, as 49% "Completely" agreed and another 37% "Mostly" agreed with that assessment. While nineteen percent were uncertain if they as students could influence decision making on issues that affected them, another 7% were completely convinced they had no influence. Regardless, fully 54.2% were more positive on this topic, expressing some level of agreement with the statement. Most (57%) completely agreed with the statement "I am happy with my chosen major field of study," and a little over 85% planned to complete their current degree pursuit at UW Tacoma. Quite a few survey respondents harbor advanced degree goals (68%), but almost 23% appear currently focused only on the bachelorette. When current academic goals are met, about twenty-two percent of respondents hope to continue their studies as graduate students, while most (58%) will work full-time.

Increasing the awareness of issues surrounding diversity and inclusion is a goal of the university. Respondents were given the opportunity to share their observations on topics related to social and diversity aspects of campus life. About 60% of survey participants acknowledged they were aware via posters and announcements of the campus focus on diversity. However, many said their participation in campus events "...where diversity issues were discussed" (164/272, 60%) was "Rare" or "Never." About 21% reported feeling some level of discrimination against them personally because of religious belief, though most of these experiences were judged to be "Seldom" (6.5%) or "Rare" (7.6%). Even though respondents reported circumstances that evidenced possible concerns with other student interactions, most respondents found relations with their fellow students quite positive, telling us they had "Frequently" or "Occasionally" "Studied with students of a racial/ethnic/religious background other than their own" (238/276, 86%). An overall favorable view of student interactions is also evidenced in that 79% of survey takers completely or mostly agreeing the campus has an environment "free of harassment."

Survey participants reviewed a selection of possible co-curricular activities, and were asked to indicate (Yes, No, Maybe) if they would stay or return to campus to participate. Respondents were not interested in fraternity or sorority participation (68%) or in "religious presentations and celebrations." Responses indicated an ambivalence toward participation in art exhibits and multimedia presentations (44%), book readings (42%) and professional performances by actors, dancers, musicians, and comedians (43%); though in each instance survey respondents indicated some interest by saying "Yes" to participation in numbers greater than "No" (

When survey respondents considered the question of offering a recommendation to attend UW Tacoma, the considerable majority (68%) would "very likely" and another 22% were "Somewhat likely" to offer that recommendation.
