II. **November 2018 OARS Reports:**

11/26/2018 **2018-11-024** Student got a drop of SB buffer in her eye. Immediately washed her eyes for a few minutes in emergency eyewash station. Instructor contacted supervisor. Student was instructed to wash again for longer and to seek medical help if needed. She washed her eyes again and told instructor and supervisor that she felt fine. Committee recommends safety goggles which protect against chemical splashes. Update lab safety manual and equipment in lab.

11/7/2018 **2018-11-031** Person received a small cut (1-2mm). He did not notice it until the blood had built up into a droplet and is unsure if it was related to activity in lab or not. Committee, follow up with student, no recommendations at this time.

III. **UWide Report – David Hirschberg:**

L&I presentation. We are one of the few states that have L&I Data on reducing injuries are staff getting punched in hospitals. Over half from medical hospitals. Concern getting folks back to work after recovery. Data about impact on campus plan facility to growing marijuana. EH&S moving forward. Hannah Wilson stated December UWide – stop the bleeding training on active shooter. Pack wound until help arrives. Bothell - robust training moving forward. University wide reports of mold at School of Dentistry. Re-org in Seattle of Safety Committee groups.
