Criteria	W: Writing
Goals	Meets BSN Goals: 4. “Appraise, critically summarize and translate current evidence into nursing practice.” and 7. “Demonstrate effective professional communication and collaboration to optimize health outcomes”
Structure	Free writes, Posters, Presentations, Discussion boards, Portfolio, Research paper (with Graded drafts), Ungraded writing with feedback, Reflection papers, Group writing, Letters to policymakers. APA Style and Support from the writing center. Class size less than 30 Include a writing related question in the course evaluation
Assessment framework	W course syllabi (350, 430, & 414) will be reviewed by the appropriate curriculum committee every third year prior to campus review beginning fall 2019.

Criteria	W: Writing
Goal	1. Use multiple communication strategies that enhance positive human relationships and facilitate effective engagement with healthcare clients/customers and workforce personnel;
Structure	Reviews of scholarly papers; intensive and ongoing written assignment involving peer and faculty reviews and feedback; critical analysis and synthesis of the technical components of written documents. <ul style="list-style-type: none">• APA formatting and presentation of written reports• Class size <30 students
