COURSE CONFLICT/TUITION IMPLICATIONS & MODEL SCHEDULE VARIATIONS

*Consult <http://opb.washington.edu/content/tuition-and-required-fees> for tuition implications when taking more than 18 credits in any given quarter. Options for avoiding heavy credit loads and/or additional tuition expenses include:

- a) Global Scholar Award (typically \$750) can partly compensate, or...
- b) Schedule permitting, TBUS 350 could be taken in the second win qtr to avoid extra tuition, or...
- c) Find an equivalency (in second win qtr?) to waive TGH 303, or...
- c) Drop TGH 303 and complete GH's Leadership Pathway (<http://www.tacoma.uw.edu/global-honors/global-honors-pathways>) instead of minor in GE.

NOTES : This model has been designed to minimize disruption to the recommended Accounting schedule. However, Global Honors courses are intended to be taken sequentially, and an arrangement that spreads them more equally over two years might be possible (e.g. taking TGH 301 in the first winter quarter and taking TBUS 310 in the second winter quarter). Consult the Global Honors Program Administrator and an Academic Advisor to discuss your options.
