Transfer steps

- 1) Schedule the **Writing Skills Assessment**.
 - You may take the WSA at any UW campus
 - You may use the same WSA test session to apply to Milgard and Foster (if applicable)
 - Select students may be eligible to take the TOEFL or IELTS instead.
 - Your WSA may be taken *after* you submit your Milgard application.
- 2) Submit **UW Tacoma** application
 - Make sure you meet all the admission requirements at the time you apply
- 3) Submit **Milgard School of Business** application

Once you are offered admission to UW Tacoma, Milgard will process your application.

At time of application, students need:

- 60 credits completed and a 2.75 overall & business GPA
 - Completed: English Composition, Intro to Financial Accounting, an economics course and 2 other prerequisite courses completed.
- *Micro or Macroeconomics needs to be completed at time of application.

At time of admission, students need:

- All prerequisite courses will need to be completed before the quarter of admission.
- Minimum of 2.0 in all prerequisite classes
- Accounting students must earn a minimum 2.5 grade in all accounting prerequisites and a cumulative 3.0 average across accounting courses.
