TACOMAPROBONO Student Internship Opportunities

The mission of the TACOMAPROBONO Program is to facilitate access to volunteer attorney advice and representation, as well as self-help materials and general legal information, for low-income individuals who have civil legal needs in Pierce County, Washington. We are the only agency in Pierce County that provides free legal advice to clients addressing such a broad range of legal issues. Our program assists low-income people in solving civil legal issues such as dissolution, parenting plans, tenant rights, consumer rights, estate planning, guardianships, bankruptcy, and many other types of non-criminal legal problems. We serve over 2,000 clients annually, mainly through clinical programs staffed by volunteer attorneys and facilitated by student volunteers.

TACOMAPROBONO is looking for student interns to join us as we serve the ever-growing legal needs in Pierce County. Our program utilizes students to conduct client screenings, work under the supervision of attorneys to prepare pleadings and discovery requests and responses, conduct legal research on actual cases, provide court support to clients, and provide support to attorneys during legal advice clinics.

Law students, undergrad students, and paralegal students have the opportunity to:

- Conduct phone screenings and client intakes to interview clients and identify legal issues
- Prepare pleadings and discovery requests and responses
- Conduct legal research on actual cases
- Provide court support to clients
- Work directly with volunteer attorneys and experienced paralegals
- Facilitate and provide support to volunteer attorneys during legal advice clinics
- Learn about the local court system

We are currently looking for volunteers who can demonstrate the following core characteristics:

- Work collaboratively as part of a team
- Extend dignity and empathy to clients
- Maintain the strictest confidentiality and discretion
