This position will assist our faculty with launching a School Psychology program with a target date of autumn 2020. During 2019-2020, this position will have primarily teaching responsibilities in our Dual-Track K-8 Special Education and M.Ed. for Practicing Educators' programs. This position has a nine-month faculty contract with compensated responsibilities starting on September 16, 2019. Compensated summer teaching opportunities may be available for interested candidates.

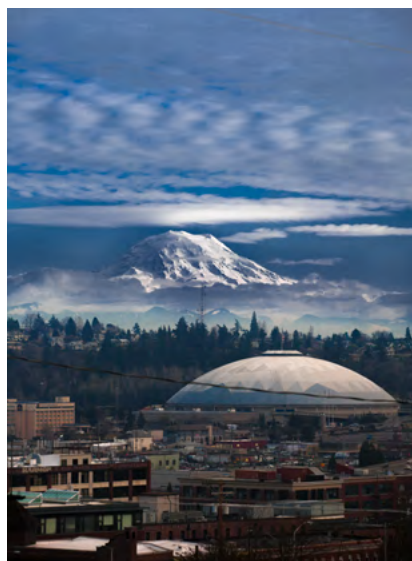

THE KEY DUTIES OF TENURE-TRACK FACULTY:

- Assist with the design, implementation, and promotion of our School Psychology program for a target autumn 2020 launch.
- Teach six courses per academic year including face-to-face, hybrid, and online courses. This position may receive a course reduction during the design and launch year of the School Psychology Program- details to be negotiated with the Dean upon hire.
- Develop and maintain a rigorous scholarly agenda in the candidate's area of expertise that directly contributes to SOE's mission and values.
- Actively participate in accreditation, assessment, curriculum development, program review, and related activities to assist SOE with its ongoing continuous-improvement efforts.
- Service expectations to the school, campus, and relevant external bodies include:
