

WHEN TO REGISTER FOR AUTUMN QUARTER 2020

Registration Period I begins May 8 @6 am



- Continuing students
- Continuing veteran & ROTC students
- Continuing veteran spouses receiving VA benefits only

Registration Period I Priority Dates

Registration priority begins at 6 a.m. on your priority registration date. You may make changes on MyUW any day after your priority date.

Registration Period II

For new veteran students:

begins Jun. 19 @8:30 am

For new and returning students

Jun. 22 @midnight – Sept. 29

Cross-campus registration also opens this period.

Veteran students and veteran spouses May 8 @6 am

*Seniors or postbaccalaureates who plan to graduate December 2020 or March 2021 and have a degree application on file by **May 6** may register on this priority date.

**As needed based on approval by the office of Disability Resources for Students (DRS). Others register by class level.

ACCESS students and university staff using their exemption status register beginning **Oct. 2**. Washington state employees using their exemption status register beginning **Oct. 3**.

Registration Period III

Sept. 30 – Oct. 6 @midnight

Nonmatriculated students and Changes of registration

Last period to make changes to your schedule or withdraw without owing tuition or fees.

Late Add Period

begins Oct. 7

All courses added during this period require an entry code or faculty number. \$20 change of registration fee.

Unrestricted Drop Period

Oct. 7 – 13

\$20 change fee plus tuition forfeiture fee. Dropped courses will not appear on transcript.

Current Quarter Drop Period Oct. 14 – Nov. 17

\$20 change fee plus tuition forfeiture fee. Dropped courses will appear on transcript with "RD."



You must register for at least one course before the quarter begins.

A \$25 late registration fee is charged to students who have not registered for at least one course before the first day of the quarter.
